In a heartwarming speech at a recent event, Army veteran Robert shared his journey of transformation with the help of Believet Canine Service Partners and his loyal service dog, Emma. Robert, an Army veteran and former police chief, recounted his life's ups and downs, culminating in his experience with post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) and the overwhelming challenges that followed.

Reflecting on his journey, Robert expressed gratitude for the support and guidance provided by Believet,

stating, "It took me 30 some years to realize that a service dog could be beneficial, and I was encouraged by a doctor at the V.A. to come to Believet." After visiting several programs nationwide, Robert and his wife toured Believet and were immediately convinced that it was the right place for them.

Robert emphasized the unique and profound impact of service dogs, not only for himself but for countless veterans who share the trauma of combat. He highlighted how Believet's proactive approach in addressing the needs of veterans was a game-changer, stating, "Believet was the best thing because it enabled me to have a totally different outlook on my life."
